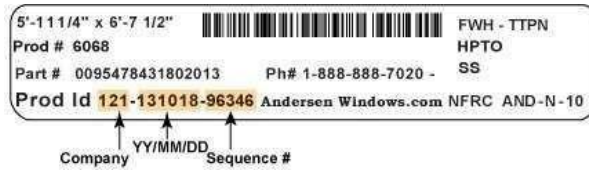

STEP 1 Product ID Number: _____ For patio doors manufactured 2007 to Present, please look for the Product Identification label in the head or side of the frame. All products manufactured 2007 to Present will have a Product Identification label. This label includes the Product Identification Number, which provides the patio door type, size, color and other important details.



STEP 2 Andersen® Glass Logo Information: _____

All Andersen® patio doors have an Andersen® glass logo in the corner of the glass. The glass logo is etched into the glass surface and is usually found in the bottom corner. Please record the *entire Andersen® glass logo information* found around the glass logo in the space provided above. If you are unable to locate the glass logo, contact us for further assistance.















STEP 3 Visible Interior Glass Dimensions: Width: _____ inches Height: _____ inches







STEP 5 Select the Exterior Color: White was the original exterior color. All other colors, unless specified, were introduced in 2008.
